Mr. Dominick Peter Carriero, age 82, of Utica, passed away unexpectedly on Sunday, November 21, 2010 at The Pines at Utica.

Born in Utica on July 13, 1928, Dominick was the son of the late Pietro "Peter" and Pasqualina (Sirianni) Carriero. Raised and educated locally, he was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School. A United States veteran, he served his country in the U.S. Army. He was united in marriage to the former Elizabeth J. Phelps and the couple shared in a loving and devoted union until his passing. At one time, Dominick held a position as foreman with the former Associated Transport. He subsequently retired from the City of Utica as coordinator of the Housing and Urban Development program (HUD) which he was instrumental in developing. One of his favorite pastimes was meeting with his Army buddies on Thursday mornings. He was a parishioner of St. Anthony & St. Agnes Church.
