



## Mr. Dominick R. Robertello

July 10, 1934 - September 23, 2014

Mr. Dominick R. Robertello, age 80, passed away on Tuesday, September 23, 2014 in the comfort of his home with his loving family by his side after a long illness.

Born in Utica on July 10, 1934, Dominick was the son of the late Dominick R., Sr. and Josephine (Campola) Robertello. Raised and educated locally, he was a graduate of TR Proctor High School and attended Utica College. A proud veteran of the United States Army, he honorably served his country from 1953-1955. On Valentine's Day, February 14, 1957, Dominick married the former Joyce E. LaPointe with whom he shared a wonderful marriage of 56 years. They were the center of each other's life until Joyce's passing on September 25, 2013.

Dominick was employed as a mail carrier for many years at the United States Postal Service, retiring in 1990. After retirement, he held a part time position at Enterprise Rent-A-Car for 16 years, a job he thoroughly enjoyed. Dominick was cherished for being a wonderful and devoted father and grandfather.

Dominick enjoyed golfing and had been a member of the Eagles Golf Club for many years. He also enjoyed vacationing with family and friends and early on, bowling on co-ed teams which he had done for many years. Dominick and his beloved Joyce built their life upon their strong faith in God and their church, Our Lady of the Rosary. Dominick was a long time member of the Nocturnal Adoration Society. He was dedicated to St. Jude, St. Anne's Shrine, and the Miraculous Medal.

Dominick is survived by his daughter and son-in-law, Donna M. and Tom Ryan of Schuyler; his sons and daughter-in-law, Richard D. and Elizabeth Robertello of Malta, NY, and David M. Robertello of Liverpool, NY; his grandchildren, Marcus Ryan, Michael Ryan; Christopher Robertello, Lauren Robertello, David Robertello, Aaron Robertello, and Arianna Robertello; and his brother and sister-in-law, William J. and Patricia Robertello of Oriskany. In addition, he leaves many nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, cousins, and in-laws, Joyce Robertello of Utica, and Marilyn and Ken Ferris of Camden; and special friends. He was predeceased by his brother, Frank J. Robertello; his brother-in-law, Richard LaPointe; and his great-niece, Nicole Robertello.
