



## Dominick A. Carlo

August 26, 1918 - February 7, 2006

Mr. Dominick A. Carlo, age 87, of Utica, passed away on Tuesday, February 7, 2006, at the Masonic Care Community of NY where he currently resided. His family was by his side at the time of his passing. Born in Utica on August 26, 1918, Dominick was the son of the late Vincenzo and Mary (Fiore) Carlo. He was raised and educated locally.
