July 7, 1914 - December 5, 2008

Mr. Dominico J. Talerico, age 94, of Utica and White Lake, NY, and a resident of the Masonic Home, passed away on Friday, December 5, 2008 at the Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center.

Born in Utica on July 7, 1914, Dominico was the son of the late Francesco "Frank" and Gaetana (Collea) Talerico. He was raised and educated locally. A veteran of the U. S. Army, he served his country honorably during World War II. On July 7, 1954 he married the former Pauline Inserra with whom he shared 48 years prior to her passing on August 22, 2002; the couple shared a loving and devoted union.

At one time, Dominico held a position with Utica Cleaners. He lastly was employed with the Municipal Housing Authority, the job from which he retired. He was a parishioner of St. Mary of Mt.
