Mrs. Doris M. "Dorrie" (Bowie) Piccione, age 87, was reunited with her husband and son as she passed away on Tuesday, November 1, 2016. She previously had been cared for by her son, Michael, Kelly, and her daughter Sandy.

Born in Newport, NY on July 5, 1929, Doris was the daughter of the late Emily (Guller) Bowie. She had a great love for Mom and admiration and gratitude for her Guller grandparents who were so kind to her during her childhood. On January 14, 1948 she married Charles R. "Charlie" Piccione and they loved each other unconditionally throughout their 68 years of marriage. She had a difficult early life, but when she and Charlie married and began their own family, her life took a turn for the better. She was a meticulous woman who maintained her home, had meals on the table, and made her family the most important consideration on her mind. She was always in her home and was a bit of an introvert. She felt blessed to be the mother of 6 children and had wonderful memories of their home on Square

Street where she raised her kids. The Christmas season was special to Dorrie and she was fascinated by her Christmas tree and all of its decorations; you could see her sitting in her blue chair in amazement of its uniqueness.

Until a couple of years ago, Dorrie would read the Observer-Dispatch from front to back. She often wrote down her daily thoughts in her good penmanship. She enjoyed a leisurely ride in the countryside, taking note of new locations in the area. One of her favorite treats was vanilla ice cream. Dorrie was a convert to Catholicism, and saying her prayers brought her solace and uplifted her spirit.

Doris is survived by her children and their loves, Joseph R. Piccione, Sandra (Piccione) DiCamillo, Charles H. "Chuck" Piccione, Patrick and Ann Piccione, and Michael Piccione and Kelly Stucky.
