



## Dorothy L. (Cosilmon) Noti

May 20, 1927 - January 31, 2009

Mrs. Dorothy L. (Cosilmon) Noti, age 81, of New Hartford, passed away after a brief illness on Saturday, January 31, 2009 in the privacy of her home with her loving family by her side.

Born in Syracuse on May 20, 1927, Dorothy was the daughter of the late Harry and Pheobe (Johnson) Cosilmon. She was raised and educated in Oxford, NY. On October 23, 1954 she married Anthony F. 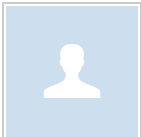
