Ed was an Army veteran who enjoyed reminiscing about when he was a Small Arms Instructor stationed at Ft Bliss, Texas. He also liked talking about the family farm, formerly in Deerfield. How many times did he recollect about riding horses in the desert in Texas or being trapped in a silo with his brother when he was little? A lifetime Utica resident, Ed was a Union Carpenter and Foreman, and also operated his own remodeling business. Later he became a Building Inspector for the City of Utica for 33 years until his retirement. In between Ed worked every holiday at the Utica Post Office and also drove truck (after work) for an air freight company to and from the Syracuse airport. 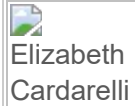
