



Eleanor F. (Mallozzi) Sitrin

Mrs. Eleanor F. (Mallozzi) Sitrin passed away on Sunday, June 30, 2013 in the comfort of her home with her loving family by her side.

Born in Utica on June 17, 1931, Eleanor was the daughter of the late Anthony and Nicoletta (Creo) Mallozzi. She was raised and educated locally. At one time she was wed to James Setzer. She was blessed with a second union when she married Richard Sitrin in 1979 with whom she shared 19 years. Richard passed away on November 8, 1998.

Eleanor worked as a Nurse's Aide and later in Occupational Therapy at the former Broadacres Nursing Facility, retiring in 1979.
