Her Catholic creed was an important part of her life, and much good came from her intended prayers for others. It was evident that Eleanor knew her Lord, especially in times of need. Graceful and kind, was how she chose to live her many years. She was a member of St. Mary's Church in Clinton. Eleanor inspired all those she encountered to do their best, and to know her was a blessing.

Eleanor is survived by her loving and devoted husband, Frank; and their sons and daughters-in-law, Dr. Michael and Mary Tucciarone, and Frank, Jr., and Kathy Tucciarone. 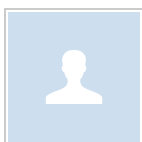
