



Elizabeth "Liz" Bowens Preston

August 6, 1940 - July 18, 2022

UTICA – Elizabeth “Liz” Bowens Preston, age 81, went home to Heaven and her Lord on Monday, July 18, 2022 with her loving family by her side.

Born in Clayton, Alabama on August 6, 1940 to the late James and Lealer Bell (Herring) Bowens, at a young age, she relocated with her parents to Utica to be close to family. She spent the remainder of her childhood in the area, attending Bagg and Kernan Elementary Schools, and graduated from Utica Free Academy in 1958. She was also the first Black Cotillion Queen. In 1973, she married William Preston.

Elizabeth began her career in 1958 with the New York Bell Telephone Company where she ascended to the position of telephone operator supervisor. She was recognized as an amazing asset to the organization, steadfast and always committed in her work, and was justly regarded very well by those she worked alongside. She never once missed a beat, and, she always took the utmost pride in her responsibilities to her job. In 1991, after 33 years of faithful service, she retired from the company, which was then known as AT&T.

In addition to her accomplishments in her professional career, she was a prime example of motherhood. By her example, she taught her daughters the core values they needed to succeed. Whether it was being true to themselves, excelling in their education and work, or balancing their home life, her children learned how to properly manage these skills from her. The best word to describe her personality is “tenacity,” and she will be remembered as a multi-

faceted spirit.

Elizabeth drew the most joy from her family and friends – yet clearly her brothers took the title for her favorite people in the world. They all have special memories of her goodness, kindness, and unyielding love. Her siblings will remember her as “the caretaker” of the bunch, and she extended that love and care to the next generations of kids that came along. It became a regular occasion for her younger siblings to gather at her house, where they’d listen to her vast record collection and learned the newest dances. She reflected her own mother’s kindness and loving spirit to the rest of her family.

Elizabeth gained a reputation for her generosity and love of others. She made a lasting impression on other people, had an animated sense of humor, and much like her father James, she’d tell it like it was, always being direct! Over her life, she gained the affection of so many who looked to her for love. She was truly a remarkable and unforgettable woman and will be so missed.

Holiday dinners were the occasions she made some of her best memories. She also considered annual family reunions and picnics at Verona State Park a must, to attend. Liz could truly be described as a people person, as she loved getting together with special friends and family. She was the queen of macaroni salad and made the best rum sweet potato pies.

A woman of many talents, at one time her skill as a vocalist earned her an offer of a full scholarship to the Boston Conservatory at Berklee School of Music, which she declined. Yet, she never let music slip out of her life. She used her incredible gift to provide entertainment for her family and to sing at both Hope Chapel and St. Paul’s Baptist Church. Elizabeth also sang jazz at the Birdland, a black jazz club, located on Bagg Square in Utica. One could say that music was part of her DNA as her entire family is gifted in the area of music. Her talents were in demand in the community as she also sang at many local Catholic weddings.

Elizabeth stayed active and had an athletic and competitive spirit. An avid bowler, she bowled regularly in local leagues, with her sister cousins, and often competed in tournaments. She also excelled in basketball, volleyball,

and softball. Her love of sports began when she was in school and continued well into adulthood in community-based leagues.

A faithful and active worshipper, Elizabeth cultivated a beautiful relationship with the Lord. Her faith never wavered, only blossomed and grew. She especially loved to share the vocal talents He gave her, by singing in the choirs at church. She faithfully did all the work the Lord planned for her, and she now has a home waiting for her in Heaven. Liz was a member of St. Paul's Baptist Church.

Elizabeth leaves behind her "pearls," Tracy J. Bowens (Larry), and Melanie L. Preston. She was also loving grandmother to Teylor, Basia, and Demetrius. She also held dear the memory of her grandson, James Henry Bowens IV, who passed away in 1987. She leaves behind her siblings, John, James (Brenda), Michael (Shirley), Evelyn, Steve (Chenno), Sandra (Ted), Kenneth (Melinda), Cheryl, Bruce (Craig), Doris, Lealer, Edwina, Phillip (Robyn), and Larry (Flatcher) Beavers. She was predeceased by her brother, Harvey Lee Bowens; her beloved sisters, Arlene McFadden, and infant Betty Lou Bowens; and her cherished sister-in-law, Oreatha Bowens. Her memory will live on with a host of nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, cousins and friends. Her sister-cousins were such a huge part of her life, and they did just about everything together: Robbie Jean Dancy, Dosier Grant, Minnie Warmack, Mary Alice Wells, Ann Warmack Washington, and Pauline Bright. She is now back with the beloved sister-cousins who went before her: Arnette Jefferson, Ella Mae King, Lizzie Washington, Eula Jackson, and Annie Ruth Bell. She was also predeceased by her brother-in-law, Larry Preston.

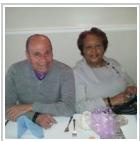
