Mrs. Elizabeth "Betty" (Trivieri) Salamida, age 93, passed away on Friday, December 27, 2013 at The Pines at Utica with her son, Mark, by her side. Born in Utica on December 11, 1920, Elizabeth was the daughter of the late Carmen and Rose (Parisi) Trivieri. Raised and educated locally, she was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School/Class of 1939. On November 22, 1945 she married John S. Salamida with whom she shared 58 loving years until his passing on June 19, 2004.

For many years, Betty was employed by The Princess Shop as a bookkeeper. A devoted matriarch, Betty was grateful for all the opportunities presented to her during her lifetime and the accomplishments she achieved. She was very capable in the kitchen where she enjoyed cooking for her family and was most renowned for her acclaimed baked lasagna. She treasured her time at the family camp at Black River which was one of her most favorite pastimes.
