



## Eugene F. Parenti

February 2, 1928 - March 26, 2008

Mr. Eugene F. Parenti, age 80, of N.Utica, passed away unexpectedly on Wednesday, March 26, 2008 at the Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center. Born in Queens, NY on February 2, 1928, Eugene was the son of the late Guido and Aurdy (Pursching) Parenti. He was raised and educated in New York City. A veteran of World War II, he served his country as a seaman 1st class in the U. S. Navy and after his time in service he relocated to the Utica area.
