



Mrs. Eve Juliette "Eva" (Plescica) Bottoni

December 1, 1931 - January 30, 2015

Mrs. Eve Juliette "Eva" (Plescica) Bottoni, age 83, went to be with the Lord when she passed away on Friday, January 30, 2015 at the Martin Luther Home after a long convalescence. At the time of her passing, her loving family was by her side.

Born in Utica on December 1, 1931, Eve was the daughter of the late Anthony and Filomena (DeNicola) Plescica. Raised and educated locally, she was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School/Class of 1949. She furthered her education at Utica College. She was married to George A. Bottoni, a 40-year union that was blessed with three children, Eileen, Jeanne, and George, Jr. Eve enjoyed a diverse working career. She was employed by Dr. Demetrius Skamus in his medical office for a period of 14 years. She was instrumental in the formation of the American Committee on Italian Migration (ACIM) where she would help place Italian families who settled in the Utica area after emigrating from Italy. During the 1960's, Eve served as Secretary to the Oneida County Executive, Harold Kurch. She also worked as a Mary Kay Cosmetics distributor for 20 years. During the 1970's, she and her husband owned and operated Parkway Liquors. For many years, Eva and her daughter Eileen took trips together and frequently visited the Saratoga Springs Race Track where they had many good times. Eileen had fond memories of attending classes at Utica College together with her mom who was her best friend. Eva's daughter Jeanne remembers hosting holidays for over thirty years with mom always involved in all the family festivities during that time.

Eva loved celebrating special occasions and spending time with her loved ones. During her leisure time, she enjoyed listening to music, spending time at the beach, and traveling. She was a devout Catholic and a communicant of St. Mary of Mt. Carmel/Blessed Sacrament Parish.

Eva is survived by her daughters and sons-in-law, Dr. Eileen (Migliaccio) and Terry Couch, and his son Matthew D. 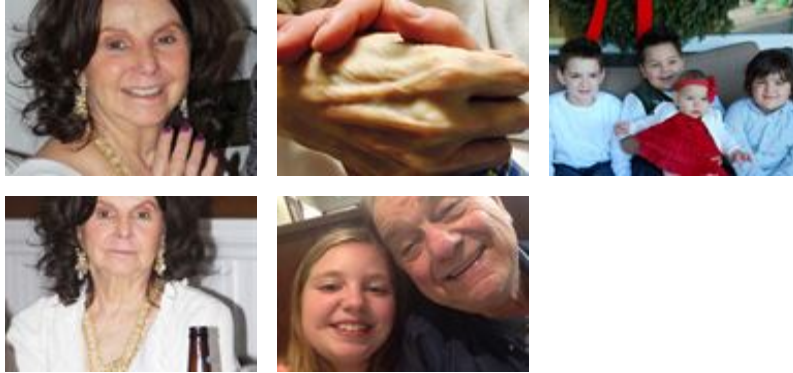
