Mrs. Felicia M. (Patrizio) Grassi, age 91, passed away on Wednesday, March 4, 2015 at the St. Elizabeth Medical Center with the love and devotion of her loving family by her side.

Born in Utica on October 29, 1923, Felicia was the daughter of the late Rocco and Antoinette (Tutino) Patrizio. She was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School/Class of 1943. On March 2, 1957, she married the love of her life, Albino Grassi, and they shared 36 blessed years prior to his passing on May 10, 1993.

Felicia was employed for more than 45 years with the Joseph & Feiss Company. Successfully and conscientiously fulfilling the secretarial and payroll duties which she was originally assigned, she was appointed Office Manager for the firm, a position she held until her retirement in 1988. At one time, she was an active member of the American Clothing Workers of America.

Felicia was a dedicated homemaker who was meticulous in tending to her household. Gifted with a kind and concerned nature, she was an excellent and thoughtful friend and caretaker. She was a communicant of St. Mary of Mt. Carmel/Blessed Sacrament Parish and belonged to the Busy Bodies Club, St. Anne Society, and Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Society.

Felicia was very close to her brother, Dr. Louis Patrizio, and cherished his memory in her heart since his passing on December 31, 2000.
