Mrs. Florence (Spirsi) Maggiolino, age 84, of Utica, passed away on Tuesday, April 11, 2006 at the St. Elizabeth Medical Center with her brother by her side. Born in Utica on May 30, 1921, Florence was the daughter of the late Benny and Anna (Alasante) Spirsi. She was raised here and attended local schools.
