Mrs. Florence R. "Florie" (Leone) Rizzo, age 75, of Utica, went home to be reunited with those who have gone before her, when she passed away on Wednesday, February 24, 2016 after many years courageously battling cancer. She made her final journey with the love and support of her family by her side.

Born in Utica on February 1, 1941, Florence was the daughter of the late Victor C., Sr. and Carmella "Cora" (Canzaro) Leone. She was the perfect combination of her parents' best virtues. She possessed her mother's wholesome kindness and her father's determination. She was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School. In 1961, Florie married her best friend and high school sweetheart, Frank Rizzo. For 10 years, they shared their love until Frank's untimely passing on December 18, 1971. Florie and Frank were made for each other and are now reunited.

Over the years, Florie worked as a sales associate at the Boston Store and the Montgomery Ward Department Store. Lastly, she was employed as a telephone operator with the New York Telephone Company. Florie had an open heart, and when in her company, you knew you had her undivided attention and concern, from the gleam in her eyes to the smile on her lips. She extended her love to her grandchildren, attending all their school functions and sporting events. They were graced with a grandma they admired and emulated. Florie was often the

She was respectful of family traditions, and the Christmas season was sacred and filled with stories galore. Florie's favorite holiday ritual was the lost art of baking pitsi en chiusa cookies, a tradition her daughter Kim will carry on. Florie honored her siblings and their families, and held them close to her heart. She found fun in the relationships she held with her aunts, cousins, and friends, alike. Day trips with Carmella and David on Tuesdays were memorable and she also brought along Aunt Dorothy, Mariah, and Morgan. Family vacations were filled with special memories and fun-filled moments. She remained in close contact with both her family and friends through her "Cousins Club" and "Ladies Club" gatherings. She enjoyed games of chance and visits to the casino, especially Turning Stone, and a memorable trip to Las Vegas with her friends.

A devout Catholic, Florie was a faithful communicant of her family parish, St. Anthony & St. Agnes Church and a member of the St. Theresa Society. She participated in Novenas and volunteered her time working the venues at the annual feast of Saints Cosmas and Damian.

Florie leaves a legacy, not only of her love, but also of her wisdom, much of which she received through her devotion to the Lord.

Her family and friends will mourn, yet rejoice, because this wonderful woman graced their lives.
