



Fradino "Dino" Mastrangelo

January 19, 1933 - January 9, 2009

Mr. Fradino "Dino" Mastrangelo, age 75, of Utica, and formerly of Rome, NY, passed away peacefully on Friday, January 9, 2009.

Dino attended Rome schools and served in the U.S. Navy during the Korean Conflict. He later worked at Griffiss Air Force Base. On January 14, 1961, he married the former Clara E. Marino.
