



## Frances T. (Juliano) Marino

April 9, 1939 - October 15, 2012

Mrs. Frances T. (Juliano) Marino, age 73, of Utica, went home to be with the Lord when she passed away on Monday, October 15, 2012 at the Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center. Fran's illness was, thank the lord, only of a short duration, but it was met with the love and fierce support of her family helping her through her battle.

Born in Utica on April 9, 1939, Frances was the daughter of the late John and Mary (Ray) Juliano. She was raised and educated locally, attending Utica Catholic Academy. On July 30, 1960 she married Anthony J. Marino. Their life became more complete at the birth of each of their children and so much of their joy together was generated by their parental stability and support, and the unique relationship shared with each of their children. They were so proud and especially cherished their time together at their second home in Deerfield Beach, FL.

Fran held positions at the General Electric Company, and the Oneida County Board of Elections. She also had several opportunities that allowed her to express her creative side through her business ventures, Original Designs by Fran/AFJ's Sports, a retail craft and apparel store, which the latter half was named after her sons in honor of their love of athletics. During the years, Fran met life with open arms and the strength to embrace whatever came her way. She truly lived life her way and on her terms all the way until the very end. Fran was the rock and foundation of her family and her passion for her children and grandchildren could not be compared. Her warm spirit and

strength shined through to her children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren who will never forget how she would always be there for them no matter what. She was the “Best Wife, Mother, Nana, and Nonnie Reeno”, the world had ever seen. Fran was, in all facets of her life, an incredibly strong adversary but more importantly an even stronger ally. Ingredients for her success in life were honor, integrity, and respect; she was one who readily gave her views but more importantly gave her heart. Fran’s trust and commitment to this community and its growth could be seen in her tenure with the Utica City School District Board of Education. As a politically minded woman, Fran conveyed her passionate views and leadership skills in the community. She will also be remembered for her service as a Democratic Committee person in the City of Utica and Oneida County. Her civic and social awareness led her to generously support local organizations, especially those that benefited children. She was a proud and vivacious New York Yankees fan; may she watch over them during this playoff season, and some of her families cherished memories will always be her masterful skills in the kitchen. Left to mourn her passing are her husband, Anthony; her daughters, Cynthia Marino and fiancé David Garcia of Deerfield, and Mary Jo Marino of Utica; her sons and daughter-in-law, Anthony J. and Kirsten Marino of Florida, Frank Marino and fiancée Felicia, James Marino and Amanda Falange, and Joseph A. and Danielle Marino, all of Utica; her adored grandchildren, Dia, Melissa, Andrea, Robert, Frangelia, Joey Jr., Anthony Michael, and Christopher; and her cherished great-grandchildren, Juliana, Genero, Roman Anthony, and James. She also leaves behind her sisters, Anna Marie Tucciarone, Rose Primarolo, and Antoinette Kelly, all of Utica; her many nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, cousins, in-laws, and her dear and cherished friend, Dr. Angela Elefante for her compassionate concern and daily calls. She was predeceased by her sister and brother-in-law, Betty Jane and Vincent F. Femia, Sr.; her brothers and sisters-in-law, James Juliano, Frank and Adeline Juliano, and John J. and Sofia “Irene” Juliano; and her in-laws, Angelo J. Tucciarone, Nick Primarolo, Sr., and Michael T. Kelly.

The family is especially grateful to Dr. Sultana Razia for her compassion and care she showed. They also want to deeply thank Dr. Michael Tucciarone; and the nurses and staff of the 6th Floor Oncology Unit at Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center, especially Cindy, Mary D., Jenn P., and Joy; and all Fran's caregivers who attended to her with great and gentle hearts.

The Marino family invites friends and relatives to celebrate a cherished life and walk alongside them during their healing process at Fran's funeral service which will commence on Saturday morning at 10:00 at St. Mary of Mt.

Carmel/Blessed Sacrament Parish where her Mass of Christian Burial will be offered by Rev. James Cesta. Fran's wishes were to have no calling hours, therefore the family will greet guests and visit with those in attendance at the conclusion of Mass. Entombment will take place in Christ Our Savior Mausoleum at Calvary Cemetery at the convenience of the family.
