



## Mr. Francis E. Foley

FRANKFORT - Mr. Francis E. Foley, age 70, passed away on Thursday, September 9, 2021, after a long battle with cancer, with his loving family by his side.

Born in Utica on September 20, 1950, Francis was the son of the late Alfred L. "Tody" and Ruth (Lerch) Foley. He was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School. A proud veteran of the United States Army, Francis served his country stationed in Korea from 1970 until his honorable discharge in 1972.
