UTICA – Mr. Francis Raymond “Frankie” Macri, age 65, unexpectedly went to be with the Lord on Saturday, December 16, 2023.

Born in Utica on October 29, 1958, Francis was the son of the late Peter J. Macri, Sr. and the late Rose (Reile) Ryder. He also knew the love and guidance of his late stepfather, Charles L. “Charlie” Ryder. Frankie attended John F. Hughes Elementary School and was a graduate of T. R. Proctor High School. At one time, he worked as a Laborer at the Mohawk Valley Psychiatric Center.

In his early days, he was a gifted athlete, playing on various football and basketball teams. His success amassed him a nice trophy collection! Frankie also loved cars, especially Corvettes. He could often be found listening to music, especially Bruce Springsteen and the band Boston. Frankie also had an excellent sense of humor. He attended Mary, Mother of Our Savior Parish, Lourdes Campus.

Frankie is survived by his sister, Sandra M. “Sandy” McNamara; his brother, Peter J. Macri, Jr.; his brother-in-law, John M.
