



## Frank Cavaretta

Mr. Frank Cavaretta, of Utica, passed away peacefully on Thursday, March 26, 2009 at Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center with his loving family by his side.

He was born in Utica on July 11, 1923, son of the late Philip and Antonetta Cavaretta. He was raised and educated locally. A veteran of World War II, Frank served in the U.S. Army 1280th Command Engineer Battalion from 1943-1946, where he was honorably discharged. In 1948, he married the former Beverlee Hyde in Utica. She passed away in 2000.
