UTICA – Mr. Frederick R. Luongo, Ret. UFD, age 82, passed away on Friday, July 25, 2025, in the comfort and dignity of his home.

Born in Geneva, NY, on May 10, 1943, Frederick was the son of the late Ralph and Rose M. (Sacheli) Luongo. As a child, he and his family moved to Utica, where he attended school and was a graduate of Utica Free Academy.

On July 6, 1966, Frederick united in marriage with the former Roseann Giovinazzo, with whom he shared over 58 years in a loving and devoted union.

Frederick dedicated several decades serving and protecting his community as a Fireman with the Utica Fire Department.
