UTICA - Mr. Frederick P. "Freddy Pep" Piperata, age 67, entered the gates of heaven on Saturday, December 5, 2020 at MVHS at St. Luke's Healthcare. Freddy was born December 28, 1952, son of Dominick and Laura M.(Pazzola) Piperata. He was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School. He was united in marriage to the love of his life Nancy J. Durdan on October 29, 1971. It was a beautiful union of 49 years together.

Freddy was a well known musician and lead singer of the band Soul Injection for over 20 years. Looking back on his career, Fred has been a frontman and lead vocalist since 1967 traveling, touring, and performing in many venues throughout Central New York, up and down the East coast, from Canada to Key West, and from Boston to Cleveland with a number of loved musicians. He has been a lead vocalist for such groups as "August", "Punch", "Flame", and "Direct Hit". Fred brought to the stage a high level of showmanship, as well as vocal leadership. Fred also played congas with the band and was an accomplished guitarist. He was a lifelong New York Giants and New York Yankees fan, and everyone knew it. Freddy was the life of the party and a natural born comedian. He had an avid love and collection of guitars that he proudly displayed. He also loved and treasured baseball memorabilia. He thought of funny, affectionate nicknames for everyone he knew and loved, a true class act, touching the hearts of the recipients.

Freddy is survived by his loving wife and soulmate Nancy "Nan"; his cherished children and their loves, first born Karin and Dwayne Murrell; his only son,

“ *The button on the website says 'Share a Memory,' and I'm hard-pressed to choose only one of this wonderful and strange man we all knew as "Freddy Pep." I've known Freddy for about 20 years, playing in Soul Injection with him, often at clubs (see also: bowling alleys) so crammed we were touching elbows. Despite our difference in age and interests, he always treated me as an equal from my first rehearsal with the band in 2002 to my last performance last winter.*

The memory of him isn't anything specific, but just sharing a ride with him and a few other bandmates a couple times on the way up to the Akwesasne casino over a decade ago. You can learn a lot about a person from a 3 hour car trip. Freddy took this time to wax philosophical on just about everything we passed, saying things like, "Look at that tree - you'll never touch that tree. How does that make you feel?" and "Look at that guy. What's he thinking about? You don't know." He often wondered if we'd ever see individual leaves again and urged us to "think about it." He also tossed limericks around at a fevered pace, sang snippets of unpublished parody songs only he knew the lyrics to, and told amazing jokes. He remains the only person that I've met that can talk so much and annoy me so little.

On the stage, nobody could match his enthusiasm, presence, and humor. In the band, we all knew the punchlines to his jokes and anecdotes, but he was so much fun that we still anticipated the punchline.

Freddy always wrote out the set lists for each performance ahead of time, and often he would include an 'extra' set list filled with fake band names and ridiculous song titles. I do not know why he did this, or why he gave them to me specifically, because it appeared I was the only recipient of the set that started with Milly Dockadoo's 'Pound It Aunt Helen.'

I have this tradition of putting a person's obituary inside the record

sleeve of music that the deceased loved the most. I was hard-pressed to think of who to put Freddy's obit in, until I remembered his strange fondness for Engelbert Humperdinck, who I now have to go purchase a record of just to store this Obit. Thanks for that one, Freddy.

I hope Freddy is entertaining a big crowd up in Heaven, still lying about his age and asking everyone to say "hello!"

My heartfelt condolences go out to Nancy and his family. You are in my thoughts.

He was forgiving yet expecting. He was stimulating without being overbearing. He pushed me to be a better drummer, singer, guitar player and professional musician. I wrote songs because and for him. Freddy also pushed himself – hard – to be great. And that's how I have always viewed Freddy Pep, great, even though he nicknamed me "Lamont DuPont," which only Freddy knew where that came from in that creative mind of his. He was an amazing person, and I will never forget him and always love him. God bless you Freddy. And god bless your beautiful family.

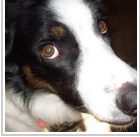
