



Frederick E. "Red" Althiser

September 2, 1938 - June 2, 2009

Mr. Frederick E. "Red" Althiser, age 70, of Utica, passed away on Tuesday, June 2, 2009 in the privacy of his home.

Born in Albany, NY on September 2, 1938, Frederick was the son of the late Percy and Ruth (Cunningham) Althiser. A veteran of the U.S. Marine Corps, he served his country from 1956-1960.

During his working life, Red achieved the rank of Lieutenant with the New York State Department of Corrections. He started his career as a correctional officer in 1960 at Sing-Sing Prison in Ossining, NY where he was also active in the local Volunteer Fire Department. He later worked at the Oneida Correctional Facility until his retirement in 1995. During his spare time, he enjoyed hunting and fishing and he was a member of the Trenton Fish & Game Club.
