Mr. Gary John Bramhall, age 61, passed away unexpectedly on Monday, January 26, 2015 in the comfort of his home.

Born in New York City on September 2, 1953, Gary was the son of Constance “Connie” Bramhall and the late Clayton J. Bramhall.
