Mr. Gary T. Conte, age 60, passed away on Sunday, August 25, 2013 at the St. Elizabeth Medical Center with his loving family by his side.

Born in Utica on February 27, 1953, Gary was the son of Rocco Conte and the late Rose (Haddad) Tahan. He was also beloved by his step-father, the late James A. 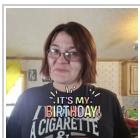
