Mr. George H. Jawahir, age 84, of Utica, passed away on Saturday, February 21, 2015 at The Pines at Utica.

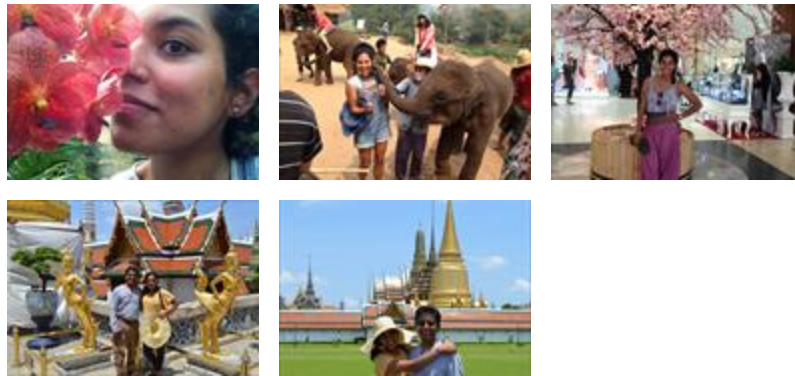
