May 11, 1924 - September 3, 2009

Mr. George C. Haddad, age 85, of Utica, passed away unexpectedly on Thursday, September 3, 2009 at the Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center with his loving family by his side.

Born in Utica on May 11, 1924, George was the son of the late Edward and Sarah (Haddad) Haddad. He was raised and educated locally. A member of the Greatest Generation and a veteran of World War II, George proudly served his country in the U.S. Army Air Corps. On November 12, 1950 he married the former Bertha Kasouf with whom he shared 58 years as partners in love and life.

George retired from the Griffiss Air Force Base after many years of loyal and conscientious service. He was a member of the Disabled American Veterans Stars & Stripes #82, and the American Legion Utica Post #229. He was a parishioner of St. George's Antiochian Orthodox Church and served many years as a church council member.

George is survived by his wife, Bertha; his son and daughter-in-law, Charles G. and Theresa Haddad of N. Utica; and his granddaughter, Sarah Haddad of N. Utica.
