Glynnis was a rock for everyone – dependable, benevolent, and selfless. She spent quality time with her children whenever she could. As a mother, she treasured doing special things for them. They loved to learn from her; she taught them cursive and many more valuable life lessons. She

She enjoyed reading her bible, writing, watching sports, cooking (sometimes for large gatherings), fishing, and spending time with family and friends (who would usually end up becoming extended family to her). Many people would agree that the food she cooked was beyond delicious, especially her mac n cheese, macaroni salad, green beans, and cabbage. Maintaining her home of greenery was of great interest to her. Her green thumb symbolized her healing spirit. There were plants all over her home, in fact, she shared cuttings that made for four households.

Her home was kept immaculate and in order. If something was disarranged, you could be sure it wouldn't be unorganized for long. Glynnis was a good shopper, always buying the perfect things for every occasion. She celebrated all major holidays and birthdays. On each of her loved ones' big days, she made it her mission to present them with a personalized cake.

A woman of faith, Glynnis was an evangelist and loved sharing the Lord's Word. She was a member of Solid Rock Church in Rome. She was a true prayer warrior; there was no room for doubt in her. Whenever Gospel music was played, she showed her affinity for the upbeat and synchronized harmony.

Glynnis is survived by her husband, Michael; her children, Curtis Lee Watson, Michael Reed, Mizell Reed, and Myesha Reed. 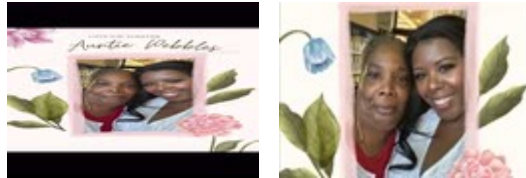
