Mr. Guy Joseph "Frank" Julian, age 83, of Frankfort, peacefully passed on Wednesday, August 4, 2010 at the St. Elizabeth Medical Center.

shared with Frank.

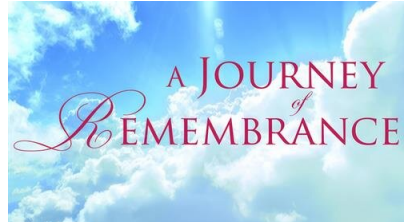
