



## Mr. Harry P. Ingalls

October 16, 1928 - June 12, 2016

Mr. Harry P. Ingalls, Retired Sergeant/NYPD, age 87, passed away on Sunday, June 12, 2016 in the comfort and dignity of his home with his loving family at his side.

Born in Washington Heights in Manhattan, on October 16, 1928, Harry was the son of the late Harold O. and Mary (O'Sullivan) Ingalls. He was raised and educated in Manhattan. 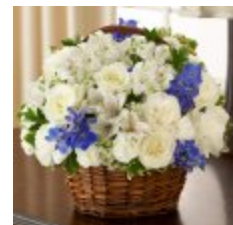
