She was never remiss in sending a card of remembrance for birthdays and special occasions. She was a sports enthusiast and a loyal supporter of the NY Yankees, NY Knicks, and professional men's and women's tennis. If you spent time with Helen, you knew that she had a penchant for going out to eat—anytime, anywhere, and the more the better. She saved room for dessert, and the check always went to her!

Helen is survived by her son and daughter-in-law, Gary W. and Vivian Price. She held close to her heart the memory of her son Joseph D. Price, Jr., who passed away in 2007.
