



Henry M. "Harry" McNally

July 17, 1911 - November 1, 2006

Mr. Henry M. "Harry" McNally, age 95, formerly of Vermont and most recently of Utica, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, November 1, 2006, in the comfort of his home.

Born in Marcellus, NY on July 17, 1911, Henry was the son of the late John and Elizabeth (Ward) McNally. He was raised and educated in Marcellus, and graduated from Marcellus High School in 1929. He completed his studies at the Central City Business Institute in 1930, which yielded him a position at the A & P Tea Co., where he worked from 1937 – 1974, in the capacity of clerk, assistant manager, and manager. In 1943 he married the former Geraldine Colomb.

Mr. McNally is survived by his wife, Geraldine; a daughter, Sister Patricia McNally, C.S.J. of Utica; two sons and a daughter-in-law, Michael McNally of New York City, and Daniel and Anna McNally of West Virginia. He is also survived by 5 grandchildren and 3 great-grandchildren; several nieces, nephews, great nieces, great nephews, cousins, and in-laws. In addition, he leaves his friends, Sister Betty and Sister Lynn. He was predeceased by two brothers, four sisters, and his first wife, Rose Young McNally.

In keeping with Harry's wishes, there will be no visitation. In lieu of flowers, contributions may be made to the Thea Bowman House or St. John the Baptist Catholic Church in Castleton, Vermont.
