Born in Singen, Germany on October 20, 1929, Irmgard was the daughter of the late Johannes and Maria Theresia (Schniederhan) Schilling, and her late stepmother, Rosa Schilling. She was raised and resided as a young adult in Germany. She came to the United States in 1958, settling in Syracuse.

In Syracuse on October 22, 1960, she wed Oskar “Dieter” Schriever. Their 63-year union has proved to be a blessing of happiness and good fortune for both of them. Ever a compliment and credit to her husband, Irmgard was proud of their heritage and common sacrifice. In 1965, she and Oskar established their home in New Hartford. They were so delighted with living in the United States that one of the first things they did when they bought their house was display an American flag outside.

Irmgard considered her family and her home her primary concerns. She gave them all of her life and heart. An exemplary woman, wife, mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother, she was also a conscientious and meticulous homemaker, who truly knew the secret of making a house a home. Her first priority was always building the most loving and strong relationships

with her husband and children.

She was always willing to contribute her time and efforts to various community causes and projects, especially her extensive volunteer work with GE ELFUNS and the Utica Maennerchor. Among her favorite leisure activities and pastimes, she especially enjoyed needlepoint and crocheting. She could often be found spending time in her garden, creating a bountiful harvest of both flowers and vegetables. She was a generous hostess, and doted over her guests. She was a wonderful cook and always made sure no one left her house hungry.

Her Catholic faith ran deep in her soul. She prized her German Bible and always wore a cross necklace.

Irmgard is survived by her beloved and devoted husband, Oskar; her children and their spouses, Marina and Christopher Kistner, and Kevin and Denise Schriever; grandchildren, Kyle and Brandy Kistner, Steven Kistner and Joshua Bateman, Erin Schriever, and Lindsey R. 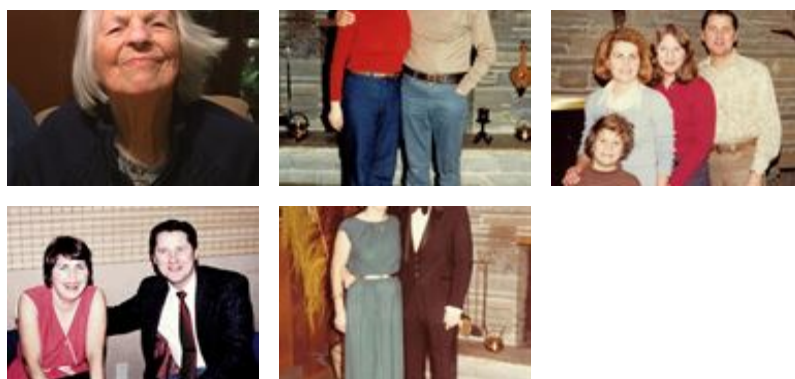
