



## Israel "Lilo" Quinones Ortiz

January 23, 1931 - August 20, 2013

Mr. Israel "Lilo" Quinones Ortiz, age 82, passed away on Tuesday, August 20, 2013 at the Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center with the love and support of his family.

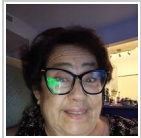

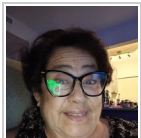
