



Mr. James F. "Jim" Quinn

July 14, 1928 - October 3, 2016

Mr. James F. "Jim" Quinn, age 88, went to be with the Lord on Monday, October 3, 2016 at the Masonic Care Community of NY with his dedicated family by his side.

Born in Utica on July 14, 1928, James was the son of the late Carroll and Rose (Albicker) Quinn. He was a graduate of St. Francis De Sales High School/Class of 1946. James was employed at a dental lab in the Winston Building located in Utica, where he was introduced to his soon-to-be-wife. He honorably served his country in the army as a Sergeant in the 336th Battalion Battery where he taught Gunnery School. On St. Valentine's 1953, Jim married the former Rita Buttimer at Historic Old St. John's Church, with whom he shared 63 years of a blessed and supportive union. He was employed with the NYS DOT as a core drill operator for 20 years.

Jim was humble and unfailingly thoughtful of others. He had a great sense of humor and inner strength. He never complained and took pride in his family and home.

Jim was a member of the American Legion Post #229 and the New York State Highway Engineers Association, a member of the New York State Public Employee's Retirement Association, and the Maennerchor Club. Jim was a parishioner of the Church of Our Lady of Lourdes, a member of the Nocturnal Adoration Society and the Knights of Columbus Council #189.

Jim is survived by his beloved wife, Rita; his daughters and son-in-law, Marianne and Hank Rickers of Poughkeepsie NY, and Sue Q. Bawarski of

Deerfield; his sons and daughter-in-law, Rev. J.
