



## Mr. James J. "Jim" Turturo, Sr.

November 7, 1930 - September 15, 2016

Mr. James J. "Jim" Turturo, Sr., age 85, passed away on Thursday, September 15, 2016 at the Mohawk Valley Health Care Center in Ilion.

Born in Frankfort, NY on November 7, 1930, James was the son of the late Nicholas and Rose (Trippin) Turturo. He was raised and educated in Frankfort, graduated from TR Proctor High School, and attended Utica College of Syracuse University. A proud veteran of the United States Army, Jim honorably served his country from 1952-1953 during the Korean Conflict. He shared a loving marriage with the former Virginia T. Carroll who passed away on December 7, 2004.
