Janice M. Cerullo, age 57, passed away on Saturday, August 31, 2013 at the Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center with the love and support of her family and friends. Janice was diagnosed with lung cancer 3 months ago and she fought the disease with great strength and her characteristic humor.

Born on January 15, 1956, Janice was the daughter of the late Frank "Whitey", Jr. and Marie C. (LaBella) Cerullo. She was raised and educated locally, a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School/Class of 1974.

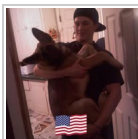
