



## Jeanne (Hoyt) Pregent

Jeanne (Hoyt) Pregent, age 75, of Frankfort, passed away peacefully on Friday, March 27, 2009 in Florida.

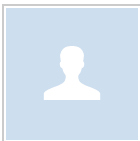
