Mrs. Jennie R. (Renno) Belmont, age 91, a native Utican and of Holland Patent, passed away on Monday, February 6, 2012 at the Charles T. Sitrin Healthcare Center with the support of her devoted and loving family by her side.

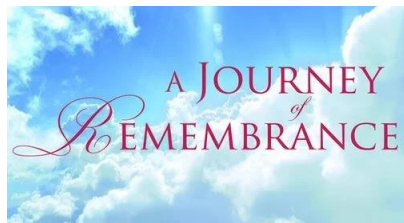
