Mrs. Jennie R. (Marino) Risucci, age 86, of Utica, passed away on Monday, February 11, 2013 in the comfort and dignity of her home.

Born in Utica on November 14, 1926, Jennie was the daughter of the late Albert and Catherine (Cittadino) Marino. She was raised and educated locally. On July 1, 1950 in St. Mary of Mt. Carmel Church she married Nicholas V. Risucci with whom she shared 62 years in a union blessed by God.

As a young woman, Jennie was employed with the Oneita Knitting Mills and later with Brown Brothers in Whitesboro where she worked at tagging goods. As a wife and mother, her family came first and foremost in her life. Her nurturing and sensitive soul extended to all God's creations and she held a special place in her heart for all types of animals, especially her dog, Corky. She enjoyed reading a diversity of fiction and non-fiction. Jennie was devoted to her Catholic faith and daily prayers. She was a member of the Confraternity of the Sacred Heart and a communicant of the Church of Our Lady of Lourdes.

Jennie is survived by her husband, Nicholas; her daughters and son-in-law, Lauren and John Jedlan of New Orleans, LA, and Linda Risucci of Utica; and her granddaughter, Juanita Fuentes of Syracuse.
