Mr. Jeremy J. Kohler, age 28, of Utica, passed away unexpectedly on Friday, February 15, 2008 at the Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center.

Born in Detroit, Michigan, Jeremy is the son of Kathy Kohler. He was raised and educated in Michigan. He enlisted with the U. S. Army and prior to his honorable discharge he was stationed at Ft. Drum in Watertown. On June 1, 2001 he married the former Martha Tuttle with whom he shared many good times in a mutually loving relationship highlighted by the blessing of their children.

After his discharge from the army, Jeremy relocated to Utica. He then began employment at APAC Customer Services, Inc., currently serving as a supervisor. Jeremy was a computer wiz, skilled at surfing the web, and he was entertained and challenged by many online games such as World of Warcraft. He also enjoyed the Harry Potter movie series, horror films, and classic rock-and-roll music. Jeremy would often help friends and relatives solve their computer problems.
