Joanne was born on May 17, 1937 in Norwich, NY, the daughter of the late Leon L. and Virginia (Bombace) Ingalls. She was a graduate of U.F.A./Class of 1955. On May 18, 1957 in St. Joseph's Church she married Edward John Bick, retired UFD and had a blessed union until his passing on May 9, 1988. Some years later, while on vacation in Austria with her family, Joanne met Bertram Barter from England. They were married on January 1, 1994.

Joanne had many talents, but her most favorite was singing. At the age of 16 Joanne joined the Parish choir of St. Joseph's Church, making her the youngest member.
