



Mr. John J. "Abe" Abramowicz

Mr. John J. "Abe" Abramowicz, age 75, of North Utica, passed away unexpectedly on Saturday, October 11, 2014 in the privacy of his home. Born in Utica on June 18, 1939, John was the son of the late William and Agnes (Krol) Abramowicz. He was raised and educated locally.
