BALDWINSVILLE/UTICA - Mr. John Lawrence Calenzo, age 90, passed away on Tuesday, November 21, 2017 at the Syracuse Veterans Administration Medical Center.

Born in Utica on August 11, 1927, John was the son of the late Michael D. and Rose M. (Lupino) Calenzo. He was raised and educated locally. A proud veteran of the United States Navy, he honorably served his country from 1945-1946. On September 17, 1948 he married the former Paulina (Sercher) Calenzo with whom he shared 30 years in a mutually supportive union that focused on raising their family. Paulina passed away on June 13, 1979.
