



## John F. "Jack" Ginnity

Mr. John F. "Jack" Ginnity, age 71, of Utica, passed away on Saturday, August 1, 2009 at the Heritage Healthcare Center with his loving family by his side. Born in Utica on August 27, 1937, John was the son of the late Hubert and Blanche (Smith) Ginnity. He was raised and educated locally, but was proud of his Irish heritage.
