Mr. John Thomas Wyborski, Sr., age 60, of Frankfort, passed away on Sunday, August 9, 2009 at the Mohawk Valley Nursing Home.

Born in Utica on November 23, 1948, John was the son of the late Valentine T. and Margaret S. (Kaczmarek) Wyborski. Raised and educated locally, he was a graduate of Utica Free Academy with the Class of 1967. A proud veteran, he served his country in the U.S. Army. At one time, he was married to the current Dorothy Acquaviva.

John worked as a New York State Corrections Officer at the Marcy State Correctional Facility for 17 years, retiring in 2006. A hard worker, he was deeply committed to his professional life.
