UTICA – Joseph G. Plano, age 61, passed away on Friday, July 4, 2025, after a courageous eight-year battle with cancer. He was surrounded by his loving family at the time of his passing.

Born in Utica on April 19, 1964, Joe was the son of the late Carl J. and Flora R. (Cuda) Plano. Raised in Frankfort, he was a proud graduate of Frankfort High School/Class of 1982.

In 1990, Joe wed the former Theresa Palumbo, and their union was blessed with the joy of their daughter. Later in life, Joe found love again with the former Anne Longo, and they were married on May 24, 2014. Their relationship was built on understanding, devotion, loyalty, and love.

For about eight years, Joe worked as a resident counselor with The House of Good Shepherd. He later accepted a position as meter repair technician with the Mohawk Valley Water Authority, where he dedicated 17 years of faithful service before retiring. For a time, he and his brother, Carl, proudly operated a local convenience store that was home to their “Famous Plano Sausage,” a true homage to their Italian heritage.

Joe was a fun-loving guy. He was quick-witted, and his comments were always spot on. He enjoyed boating, fishing, and listening to classic rock –

especially The Beatles. He also loved sitcoms and comedies, and could quote just about any line from Seinfeld.

Joe found joy in life's simple pleasures, but nothing brought him greater fulfillment and happiness than being a father. Raising his daughter was the most meaningful journey of his life.

Joe is survived by his devoted wife, Anne; cherished daughter, Therese Plano and Greg Hartunian; and his stepdaughter, Andrea Longo and her husband Ian Browning, along with their daughter, Jordice Browning; and siblings and their spouses, Ellen Laura, Gloria and Ed Smith, and Carl III and Joanne Plano. He is additionally survived by many nieces, nephews, and cousins, and their families; and in-laws, Josephine and Tom Abounader, and Julie and Tim Brown.
