



Mr. Joseph M. "Joe" Polito

August 13, 1968 - February 20, 2025

UTICA – Mr. Joseph M. “Joe” Polito, age 56, passed away unexpectedly in the comfort and dignity of his own home on Thursday, February 20, 2025.

Born in Utica on August 13, 1968, Joseph was the son of Ralph J. and Elaine (Cristalli) Polito. Raised in the area, he was a proud graduate of Notre Dame High School/Class of 1987. In his school years, he was a phenomenal athlete, excelling in football and baseball. He was tough and talented, and rose to the occasion as a team leader. In baseball, Joe was a skilled catcher, and his talents on the football field shone brightly. If you saw Joe running toward you, you went the other way! He also had a great run with Adrean Post 625 American Legion Baseball.

Joe held employment with the Utica Water Board for over 25 years, serving as a technician.

Possessing a kind and loving heart, the most important part of Joe’s existence was the beauty of his family and loved ones. He was a devoted and dedicated son who called his mom every morning, just to hear her beautiful voice. The closeness that he built with his parents over the years made him a joy to have as a son. He was a special soul that enjoyed being in the company of good friends and loved ones. “ I am so very sad for the passing of Joe. I had the privilege of coaching a young Mr. Polito for one season of East Utica, Senior League baseball, in the early 1980's. I remember Joe from the many wonderful players on that team because he made a distinct impression. Aside from being a pure hitter with a swing that rivaled Mike Piazza, he developed into a tremendous student of the game, making coaching rewarding. Joe listened and learned. I recall early on, before the season began, instructing Joe on a few catching position fundamentals; basics, such as running up the first base line when a ball was hit in the infield with no runners or one on first base. Joe dutifully complied, though it was clear he was skeptical of this fundamental. However, when he stopped his first ball that had passed the first basemen during a game, the light bulb went off and he embraced and soaked up learning and executing on the position like a sponge. I was never a baseball player of Joe's caliber and was so very proud of his progression as a baseball player and person. I also can also still clearly see that curly hair of his flopping around when he threw off his mask for a play, eyes peeled on the play at hand. Funny, how we remember little things. Joe became a leader on the field and on that team. I only got to know Joe for that one Summer, but I heard he became a stand out baseball player in High School and am so grateful I had the opportunity to know him for that brief moment in time.
