Josephine (Carino) Ferris, age 77, of Clinton, passed away unexpectedly on Monday, March 20, 2006 in the comfort of her home.

Born in Utica on April 30, 1928, Josephine was the daughter of the late Angelo and Barbara (Sumerano) Carino. Raised and educated locally, she was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School. At one time she was married to Peter Ferris, Jr.

In addition, she leaves many longtime and dear friends, including Rose Latella and Velma Schreppel. She was predeceased by a brother, Joseph Carino; and 2 sisters,

Mary Carino who passed away in infancy, and Eleanor Marcouiller.
